### **Code of conduct for Players**

- All Players must follow this code of conduct, it is not optional.
- All players will follow this code when entering their own or any other cricket ground.
- All players must at all times be of good behaviour, and show respect to their own

Captain, their teammates, their opponents and the officials with regard to the 'spirit of cricket'.

- All players must be aware of and follow the ECB policies on anti-discrimination and safeguarding of both senior and junior participants. If unsure contact your clubs' safeguarding officers. (Currently Mrs. Louise Ede, Mr. Simon Hirst). Contact details available at the club.
- Must always treat others without exception of colour, race, gender, or age in a way without prejudice.
- Must publicly accept officials' judgements.
- Must discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
- Must not verbally or physically abuse anyone.
- Must not use gross or offensive language at any time, dressing rooms included.
- Must use correct and proper language at all times to avoid misinterpretation.
- Be aware of the club's policy regarding social media platforms, content etc. If in doubt seek advice from the clubs' safeguarding officers.
- Encourage and guide participants to learn the laws of cricket accept responsibility for their own performance and responsibilities.
